



Dr Hemant Kulkarni is serving Western Australia in a capacity as a Nephrologist since 2004 and holds dual accreditation in adult and paediatric nephrology in Australia with postgraduate qualifications from India, UK and Australia.

Dr Kulkarni is Director and Head of Nephrology and Dialysis services at Armadale hospital, and also works at Royal Perth Hospital. Dr Kulkarni provides services to private patients at Wexford Nephrology in Murdoch, Armadale and Perth.

He led the Renal Health Network for 8 years and his contribution and involvement in Research was instrumental in shaping the current clinical guidelines within renal services in the state of Western Australia. He has been involved in Investigator Lead Clinical Trials, National and International Collaborative Trials and Industry Sponsored Trials for over 20 years. He remains a strong advocate for affordable patient-centred care.

Dr Hemant Kulkarni was instrumental in training and establishing WA's first Renal Nurse Practitioner, and supervising PhD student. Dr Kulkarni is recipient of "Operation Angel" award from Kidney Health Australia in recognition of his inspirational contribution to the Australian kidney community and has received multiple awards and grants. Dr Kulkarni has co-authored multiple publications in national and international journals and has been an invited speaker at national conferences.
